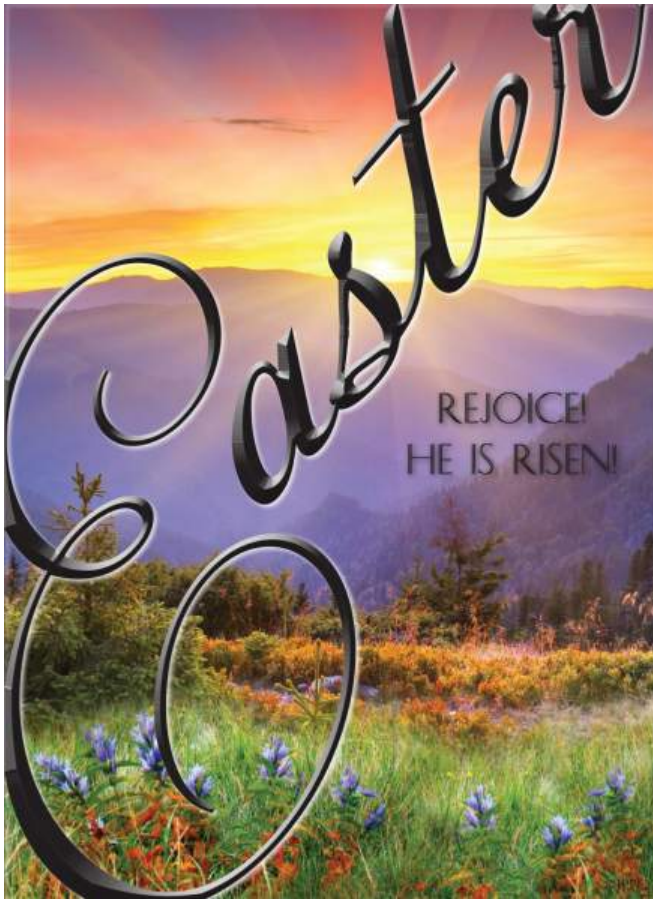

Birthright Collection Needs:

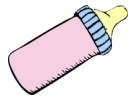
