Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday's liturgical title is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, one of the Universal Church's most awe-inspiring doctrines. But, our parish faith communities are not merely impersonal local franchises of some international corporation. We're family, brothers and sisters baptized not in the name of a doctrine, but in the name of a community of Divine Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The doctrine is upheld and believed because God has revealed this intimate truth about Himself to us.

We are baptized into the Triune God, the very source of life Itself. Yet, that life comes to us personally from the Persons of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Pope Francis said recently that faith is personal, not a theoretical idea. Our God is indeed almighty and everlasting, but also intimate and personal, a community of Persons, personally encountering us.

In the Nicene Creed, we declare Jesus "Only Begotten . . . born of the Father before all ages." St. Paul closes his Second Letter to the Corinthians, our second reading today, with a Trinitarian greeting: One that we use as the greeting at Mass. (See 2 Cor. 13:11)

He says of Jesus elsewhere that He is "the power of God, the wisdom of God." (1 Cor 1:24) and also "personalizes" the Spirit: "the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us" (Romans 5:5). In all this, we see a growing understanding of the doctrine of the Most Blessed Trinity in the early Church.

Today Jesus reveals that "that God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that all who believe in him might not perish, but might have eternal life." (Jn 3:16). God's tremendous love for us is that we not perish, but that we share in His very life through Jesus, who took on our human nature to redeem us and make it possible to enter into that Divine Life of the Trinity.

This is an act of love and mercy, which as Pope Francis wrote several years ago, reveals the mystery the Most Holy Trinity, showing us that God is a life-giving, love-sharing personal community and filling our hearts with assurance that despite our sinfulness, we are loved—personally—forever.

How can we, as individual Christians, as families and as Parish Family, reflecting the "family" of the Trinity, seek to bring that life-giving presence of our loving God to others?
